In theory, modern readers can learn a great deal about law through literature because literature often lacks the "official filter" of many traditional legal sources. Of course each individual author brings his own biases about law and the legal system to his writing. But as long as we acknowledge the potential for such bias, these sections have the potential to offer completely different perspectives and insights.
