Enemies in the Empire Jul 22 2019 During the First World War, Britain was the epicentre of global mass internment and deportation operations. A complex set of wartime legislation imposed limitations on their freedom of movement, expression, and property possession. Stefan Manz and Panikos Panayi then bring their study to the local level by concentrating on the three camps Knockaloe (Britain), Fort Napier (South Africa), and Ahmednagar (India), allowing for detailed analyses of personal experiences. Although conditions were generally humane, in some cases, suffering occurred. The study argues that the British Empire played a key role in developing civilian internment as a central element of warfare and national security on a global scale.
